



## Good Faith Deposit Payment Instructions – SBA

A Good Faith Deposit (GFD) is a required part of the application process and can only be executed from the account of a guarantor on the associated application.

As a resource, Lendistry has created these instructions on how to pay your GFD.

### How to pay by Automated Clearing House (ACH) or Wire:

1. Provide the following to your bank:
  - For ACH Delivery:
    - a. Bank routing number: 322271627
    - b. Account number: 782720608
    - c. Account name: Lendistry SBLC, LLC
  - For Wire Transfers:
    - a. Bank routing number: 021000021
    - b. SWIFT Code: CHASUS33
    - c. General bank reference address: JPMorgan Chase New York, NY 10017
    - d. Account number: 782720608
    - e. Account name: Lendistry SBLC, LLC
    - f. Company address:

2. Obtain a receipt or bank transaction document from the bank **with a trace number.**
3. Email a copy of the receipt or bank transaction document with the trace number to [gfd@lendistry.com](mailto:gfd@lendistry.com).
4. Do not cross out or cover information on the receipt or bank transaction document.
